# IT IS EQUALLY IMPORTANT TO GET YOUR SECOND DOSE OF THE VACCINE

**If you booked your first dose on the NHS website or by calling 119**

- You should have booked your second dose at the same time and received an email or text message confirming the date.

- If you walked in to one of the sites, you can call **119** or visit the NHS website to arrange a reminder or change the date:  
**nhs.uk/coronavirus**

**If you had your first dose at the John Scott or Bocking Street Vaccination Centres (or at a pop-up outreach clinic)**

- You'll get a phone call or text using the contact details you provided before the 77th day after your first appointment (11 weeks).

- If it's been more than 77 days since your first dose, email: **cahccg.gpcovid-19@nhs.net** or phone **020 7729 7236** with your name, date of birth plus the date and site you attended.
